While the Senate and Assembly worked most of Thursday to pass the budget and its trailer bills (see attached list), the houses – now in the wee hours of Friday morning – appear to be at an impasse. The main sticking point seems to be pension reform, with lots of other bills being held hostage. A most distressing situation to say the least.

We will provide you with additional details tomorrow on what we hope will be a final report of action on a 2010-11 spending plan.
